<a href="#">Navigating the AutoCAD LT Interface</a>	Beginner	0:50	
In this lesson you navigate the AutoCAD LT user interface. You begin by learning about the Quick Access toolbar and the commands that it makes available. Next you discover Ribbon panels and status bar controls, and finally you modify the appearance of interface elements.			
<a href="#">Menu Browser</a>	Beginner	0:40	
In this lesson you learn to use the Menu Browser to perform common tasks in AutoCAD LT such as opening and closing drawings, accessing commands, setting options, and exiting AutoCAD.			
<a href="#">Quick View</a>	Beginner	0:45	
In this lesson, you learn about the Quick View status bar controls and how to use them to navigate drawing views and layouts.			
<a href="#">Quick Properties</a>	Beginner	0:35	
In this lesson you adjust object properties on several different types of objects. You begin by learning about the Quick Properties panel, how to access it and how to control its visibility and behavior. You then use the Quick Properties panel to quickly change object properties.			
<a href="#">Layer Properties Manager</a>	Beginner	0:35	
In this lesson, you manage layer properties and perform other tasks while the layer properties manager dialog box is open and available. You learn that the behavior of the Layer Properties Manager is modeless, so that it allows you to perform operations in the drawing while it is open.			
<a href="#">Customizing the UI</a>	Beginner	1:15	
In this lesson, you customize aspects of the user interface in AutoCAD LT. You begin by learning how to customize the Ribbon panels and tabs. You then learn to customize the Quick Properties palettes by changing which properties are displayed and then how to enable Quick Properties for other objects. You learn how to create search tags, or keywords for commands to be used in the Menu Browser search tool. Finally, you learn to customize the Quick Access toolbar and add menu tags to commands.

In this lesson you utilize the DWFx format to exchange digital design data. First you learn about the DWFx format and how it differs from DWF, and then you learn about your options for creating, sharing, and creating markups.
